

**ORDINANCE NO. 1021**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING BRIDGEPORT CITY CODE § 90.03 WITH REGARD TO FOWLS WITHIN THE CITY.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGEPORT, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Bridgeport City Code § 90.03, and its corresponding ordinance(s), shall be amended as follows (portions stricken shall be designated as ~~such~~; portions added shall be designated as **such**):

§ 90.03 FOWLS **WITHIN THE CITY** ~~BANNED FROM CITY.~~

It shall be unlawful for any person to keep or maintain within the corporate limits any poultry, ~~chickens~~, turkeys, geese, **roosters**, or any other fowls except for those maintained as pets and/or showing animals, **other than as hereinafter prescribed.**

**Each household within the City shall be permitted to harbor up to six (6) chickens, specifically limited to laying hens, for the purpose of egg production and harvesting for personal use.**

Section 2. Any ordinance or part of any ordinance in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict. Should any part or section of this ordinance be declared void, invalid, and unenforceable, such declaration shall not affect any other part of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form according to law.
