

RESOLUTION 2025-08

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGEPORT, NEBRASKA, AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF REAL PROPERTY OWNED BY THE CITY PURSUANT TO NEB. REV. STAT. § 17-503(6)(a).

WHEREAS, Neb. Rev. Stat. § 17-503(6)(b) authorizes the power any city of the second class or village to convey any real property owned by it to another public agency;

WHEREAS, the City of Bridgeport, Nebraska, owns the following described real property which is currently utilized by Morrill County as office space for a portion of its police force; specifically that portion that is tasked with patrol in the City of Bridgeport:

Lot Three (3), Block Three (3), 10th Addition to the City of Bridgeport, Morrill County, Nebraska. More commonly referred to as 713 L Street, Bridgeport, Nebraska.

WHEREAS, the City of Bridgeport, Nebraska, desires to convey said parcel to Morrill County, Nebraska, a Political Subdivision of the State of Nebraska, a public agency as contemplated by Neb. Rev. Stat. § 17-503(6)(b):

NOW THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGEPORT, NEBRASKA, HEREBY RESOLVES, the City hereby authorizes the conveyance of the above-described surplus real property to Morrill County, Nebraska.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that subject to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 17-503, the Mayor of the City of Bridgeport, Nebraska is hereby authorized to execute all documents that may be required to effectuate the transfer of all right, title and interest of the City of Bridgeport, Nebraska in said real property to Morrill County, Nebraska.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the proceeds of the sale of the real property described above shall be placed in the General Fund of the City.
