

# ORDINANCE NO. 1011

**AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE RATES TO BE CHARGED BY THE MUNICIPALITY FOR TRASH REMOVAL SERVICE; PRESCRIBING THE TIME WHEN THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRIDGEPORT, NEBRASKA:

**Section 1: Trash Rates**

Effective on the billing date on or After November 1, 2024, the rates charged for trash removal for residents of the City of Bridgeport, Nebraska shall be as follows:

Rate Schedule for Trash Removal effective on the billing payable on or after November 1, 2024:

**Section 2: Service Charge.** Each customer shall be charged an additional \$3.00 per month to cover the cost of billing services.

**Section 3: Repeal of Previous Ordinances.** Any ordinance or part of any ordinance in conflict with this ordinance is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 4: Effective Date; Publication authorized in pamphlet form.** This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

**Section 5: Severability.** If any portion or provision of this resolution shall for any reason be held to be invalid or unenforceable, the invalidity or unenforceability of such portion or provision shall not affect any

of the remaining provisions of this Resolution, the intention being that the same are severable.
