Nebraska Medicaid

- Eligibility may be based on factors such as disability or income guidelines
- You may qualify if you are:
 - 65 years of age or older
 - Under 65 years of age, but eligible for Social Security disability
 - Aged 18 or younger
 - Pregnant
 - Parent/Caretaker
 - Former Foster Care Youth

Medicare

- Eligibility may be based on factors such as disability age requirements.
- You may qualify if you are:
 - 65 years of age or older
 - Under 65 years of age, but eligible for Social Security disability

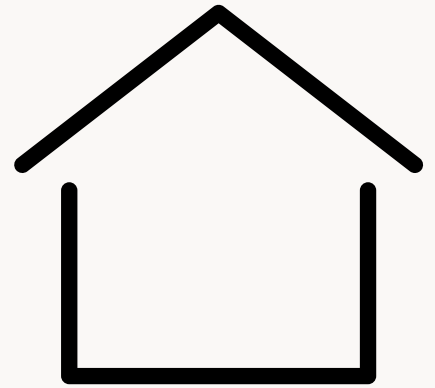

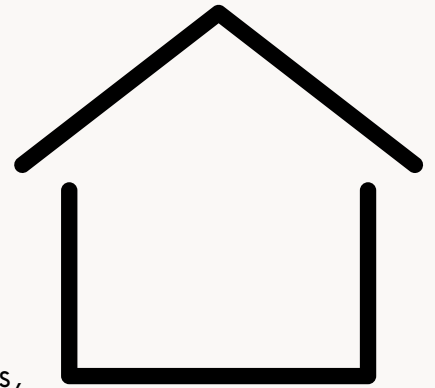

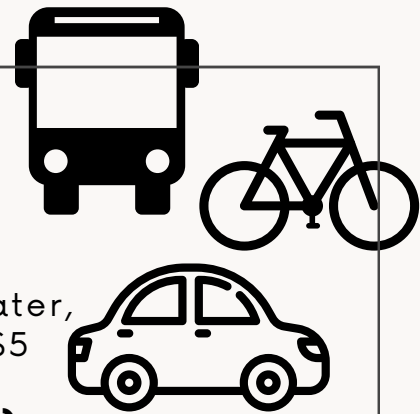
Supportive Services for Veterans and Families (SSVF)

Morrill County Public Transit

- Routes run Monday - Friday
- Routes travel between Bridgeport, Scottsbluff, Broadwater, and Bayard from 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. | cost between \$2-\$5
- These buses have lifts for wheel chair users

Community Action Health Center (CAPWN)
