- 1. All floors, including basement
- 2. All rooms, current and proposed, use of each room and dimensions
- 3. Location of structural elements and openings
- 4. Doors and windows (location, size, swing, and hardware)
- 5. Fire assemblies and separations.
- 6. Identify new/existing walls, call out construction of walls
- 7. Interior finish
